Guidelines and requirements for the absence of ingredients and environmental toxins in foodstuffs, dietary supplement, fodder, and non-food

REMA 1000's guidelines and requirements for the absence of ingredients and environmental toxins in foodstuffs, dietary supplement, fodder, and non-food

Reitan Retail and subsidiaries including REMA Distribusjon Norge AS and REMA Distribusjon Import AS (jointly "REMA") actively work on reducing unnecessary additives and the usage of palm oil and soy from countries where there is a risk of deforestation in our product portfolio.

Not permitted contents:

- Palm oil must not be used in foodstuffs.
- No products (irrespective of brand) may be sold which contain genetically modified organisms (GMOs).
- No products shall contain flavour enhancers (E 620 - E 629).
- All packaging and all products must be free of the entire group of per- and polyfluorinated substances (PFASs).
- All packaging materials shall be free of PFO/PFOS/PFCA, phthalates (DEHP) and Bisphenol A.

Contents with restrictions:

- Soy shall preferably be sourced from manufacturing countries in which there is not a risk of deforestation of forests generally accepted as rain forest
- All other soy shall have been manufactured according to Pro Terra, RTRS or similar environmental impact certifications or requirements.
- We request that the supplier be restrictive in its use of smoke flavoring.
- We request that the supplier be restrictive in its use of (other) additives.
- 2023. From 2023, no new products containing carrageenan will be accepted unless it's strictly necessary. Exceptions must be approved by REMA 1000 (exceptions will only be given if there are no alternatives). There are no exceptions for the use of carrageenan in organic products.
- Titanium oxide must be phased out in existing EMV/UMV non-food products by the end of 2023. From 2023, no new non-food products containing titanium oxide will be accepted unless it is strictly necessary. Exceptions must be approved by REMA 1000 (exceptions will only be given if there are no alternatives).

The supplier must present a specific phase-out plan or otherwise document that he works determinedly on phasing out / reducing the following ingredients, within fixed time limits:

- Palm oil in foodstuffs (applies where exceptions are granted).
- Palm oil in non-food (only certified and traceable palm oil will be approved for usage in non-food products)
- Reduction of salt, sugar, and saturated fat in accordance with the Norwegian authorities' dietary advice and the agreements between said authorities and the grocery store operators.
- E 407 Carrageenan must be phased out in existing EMV/UMV products by the end of 2023. From 2023, no new products with Carrageenan will be established unless it is

strictly necessary and must be approved as an exception to REMA 1000 if there are no alternatives. There are no exceptions for the use of carrageenan in organic products.

Criteria related to use of ingredients which may be hazardous to the health or environment:

All suppliers shall at all times work diligently with the aim of adhering to Norwegian environmental authorities' priority list of substances for which use and releases shall be terminated or materially reduced within 2020*.
